TYRANT NATIONALS TOURNAMENT PREVIEW



The time has come for the long-awaited Tyrant Nationals! Year one of the tournament has yielded a great turnout of wrestlers from all over the country. 25 States are represented by the competitors including:

PA, NJ, MD, VA, WV, NY, IL, MI, OH, FL, GA, NC, SC, TN, MA, DE, RI, CT, IN, TX, CO, WI, MO, KY, NH.

Across all divisions 30 Nationally Ranked wrestlers are set to compete. In the High School Boys division, at least 12 HS State Champs and 22 former MS State Champs will step on the mats. 45+ HS State placers, 6 National Prep AA, and 25+ All-Americans with accomplishments from Fargo, Super 32, or NHSCA.

It'll be interesting to see how it all plays out in the HS boys division with the college rules format. How will the wrestlers adjust? 3 pt takedowns, riding time, neutral danger, 4 pt nearfall, etc.

Headlining the HS Boys division is Who's Number One Winner, 2023 Fargo Junior Champion and 2022 U17 World Silver medalist, Jax Forrest (126). His teammate from Bishop McCort, Bo Bassett will compete at 132. Bo is a 2021 Cadet World Champion, 2023 Ironman Champ, and can always be found near or at the top of the national rankings.
